Project title	Nutrition in Aged Care and Foodservice in Dietetics
Hours & delivery	For the Summer program, students will be engaged for 6 weeks only. Hours of engagement must be between 20 – 36 hrs per week and must fall within the official program dates (Summer = 12 Jan – 20 Feb 2026). Hybrid- St Lucia and remote.
About the project (150–250 words)	The student will have the opportunity to participate in nutrition and dietetics research projects focused on nutrition in aged care and foodservice management in dietetics. The student will be able to engage in a range of research activities, including data collection and data analysis.
What you'll do (100-150 words)	The primary research project will be transcribing and analysing interviews focused on foodservice management education and manuscript development for a nutrition in aged care review.
What you'll learn (100–150 words)	The research student will gain and practice essential research skills through this project including conducting a literature review, data collection, data management, data analysis as well as quantitative and qualitative research methods.
Project outcomes (75–125 words)	The student will have opportunity to develop research skills including time management and communication skills. The student will have the opportunity to generate publication/s from their research.
